1. <u>MINUTE</u>

The committee then heard Alan Wright of East Calder and Wilkieston Community Council, Alex Smith, a local resident and Councillors Carl John and Dave King, local ward members, all speak in support of their objections to the application.

Decision

Agreed to continue the application for one cycle in order for discussions to be undertaken with the applicant regarding whether the through route could be blocked preferably at the north end of Mansefield Road and to allow a traffic assessment to be carried out and which was to include details of safe walking routes to schools.

3. <u>APPLICATION NO.0110/FUL/14</u>

The committee considered a report (copies of which had been circulated) by the Development Management Manager concerning an application as follows :-

The committee then heard Mr Donald Jones, the applicant's agent and Mr Waz Abbas, the applicant, both speak in support of the application.

Decision

Granted temporary planning permission for a period of two years subject to Condition One of the report and which related to the extractor fan operating times. Committee also agreed that within two months of the planning permission being issued the applicant was to submit to the council a strategy for addressing the noise issues with the roller shutters and that any agreed strategy was then to be implemented within a further period of two months.

The committee the heard the Development Management Manager suggest that if the committee was minded to grant the application then he would wish to include two additional conditions to those detailed in the report and these concerned a flood lighting strategy and reverse parking adjacent to Charlesfield Land.

Decision

Approved the terms of the report and granted planning permission subject to conditions and to include two additional conditions in that (a) details of floodlighting was to be submitted to the council and (b) commercial vehicles parking to the north and east of the site (adjacent to Charlesfield Lane) were to reverse into parking spaces at the end of the working day so that they were in forward gear in the morning.
