## 3. UPHALL PRIMARY SCHOOL PROGRESS REPORT

The committee considered a report (copies of which had been circulated) by the Head of Education (Curriculum, Quality Improvement and Performance) bringing to members' attention the progress made towards the actions arising from the school's Education Scotland inspection published in May 2019. Catriona MacRae, Seconded Head Teacher, was in attendance to provide an update on the school's progress and to answer questions from committee members.

During discussion, further details were provided about the staff rotational groups as a means for driving improvement. Parental involvement was also explored as well as a shift in the school ethos towards nurturing positive relationships as a way to address class disruption. The recent change in leadership in the school was also noted.

It was recommended that the committee note the contents of the report and the school's progress in addressing identified areas for improvement.

The committee noted the school's progress since Education Scotland's inspection and requested a further update after Education Scotland revisited the school for inspection in spring 2020.
