

5. RELOCATION OF CEDARBANK SCHOOL, LIVINGSTON

The Education Executive considered a report (copies of which had been circulated) by the Head of Education (Learning, Policy and Resources) seeking approval to relocate Cedarbank School as part of the council's continuing commitment to ensure equitable, high quality and sustainable education provision for pupils in West Lothian with a range of additional support needs related to learning difficulties and social communication needs.

It was recommended that Education Executive :-

1. Approves the proposal to relocate Cedarbank School; and
2. Notes the outcome of the formal consultation and the report of Education Scotland on the educational aspects of the proposal.

Decision
