

4. SERVICE PERFORMANCE AND WLAM OUTCOME REPORT - CONSTRUCTION SERVICES

The committee considered a presentation and a report (copies of which had been circulated) by the Depute Chief Executive providing an overview of a service assessment from the West Lothian Assessment Model process (2017/20).

The report also provided a summary of recommendations from the officer-led scrutiny panel that had been identified for action and were to be delivered by the service management team.

The report recommended that the committee:

1. Note the outcome from the WLAM and Review Panel process;
2. Note the recommendations for improvement; and
3. Agree any other recommendations that may improve the performance of the service.

The committee asked a number of questions in relation to project management and programmes and safety risk assessments.

The officer explained that projects were programmed and updated as required. It was also explained that the reasons for slippage on project programmes was monitored and adjusted to take account of delays which could be down to other services such as building services or external factors. It was also advised that all annual fire safety assessments were complete.
