


## APPENDIX 1 – INITIAL CONCEPTS FOR ALMONDELL CEMETERY, EAST CADLER

### MEMORIAL PUBLIC ART PROJECT



Idea 1: Tree of Life -



- interpretation of the Tree of Life theme.
- concept is inspired by the idea that the remembrance of the departed creates a presence for them among the living.
  - an outline of that person lives on through the actions and thoughts of other people.
- no elements of the tree itself present, instead its shape will be created by other living things.
- a celebration of life as much as a commemoration of the dead.

Idea 2: River Theme –



- shape inspired by the River Almond.
- could be done similarly to the tree idea - there is no actual water, the shape of the river is created by the living things that can be found in its habitat.
- organic, twisting tunnel, wavy structure with river animals & plants interwoven into it (or no animals).
- Made out of silver metals such as galvanised steel and aluminium.
- memorial plaques can be in the shape of a water plant, a fish, a water ripple.

### Idea 3: Bridge



- Bridge made up of flowers - local species
  - Flowers symbolising commemoration
- Could be made of 2 contrasting metals e.g. corten steel (Angel of the North) & stainless steel
- Transparent sculpture, 3D surface
- Water ripple reflections on the underside of the arch
  - Reflection symbolic of remembering
- memorial plaques can be in the shape of a water ripple reflection
