

EDUCATION SCOTLAND REPORT: WINCHBURGH PRIMARY SCHOOL AND NURSERY CLASS

The committee considered a report (copies of which had been circulated) by the Head of Education (Curriculum, Quality Improvement and Performance) informing members of the outcome of the Education Scotland (HMI) inspection at Winchburgh Primary School and Nursery Class. Ian Harvey, Head Teacher, was in attendance to provide an update on the school's progress and to answer questions from committee members.

The Head Teacher explained the school's approach to the recent area growth and resulting changes in demographics and culture; communication, honesty flexibility and inclusivity were high on the school's priorities list. Members were assured that any performance issues were being successfully addressed. Support under GIRFEC was also discussed.
