7 <u>EDUCATION SCOTLAND REPORT: WINDYKNOWE PRIMARY</u> <u>SCHOOL AND NURSERY CLASS</u>

The committee considered a report (copies of which had been circulated) by the Head of Education (Curriculum, Quality Improvement and Performance) informing members of the outcome of the Education Scotland (HMI) inspection at Windyknowe Primary School and Nursery Class.
