

7. COMMUNITY LEARNING AND DEVELOPMENT YOUTH SERVICES PERFORMANCE

The panel considered a report (copies of which had been circulated) by the Head of Education (Learning, Policy and Resources) providing an update on Community Learning and Development (CLD) Youth Services (Work with Young People (WwYP) and More Choices More Chances (MCMC) teams) performance from 1 April 2020 to 30 September 2020.

The report recommended that the panel notes the contents of the report and in particular:

1. The development of creative and innovative co-designed delivery models;
2. The establishment of a dedicated CLD Youth Services social media presence to promote the learning offer and maintain engagement with children, young people and communities;
