

5. SCOTTISH GOVERNMENT CONSULTATION: PROPOSALS FOR REGULATIONS ON LOCAL PLACE PLANS

The panel considered a report (copies of which had been circulated) by the Head of Planning, Economic Development and Regeneration advising of the proposed response to a Scottish Government consultation on proposals for regulations on the content, preparation, submission and registration of Local Plan Plans (LPPs). The panel were asked to note that Local Place Plans were a new type of community led plan, giving people an opportunity to develop proposals for the development of use of land in the place where they live.

It was recommended that the panel notes and considers the following recommendations which were intended to be submitted to Council Executive for approval :-

1. Notes the terms of the consultation from the Scottish Government and the reasons for it;
2. Approves the proposed response to the consultation as set out in Appendix 2 to this report; and
3. Agrees to submit the report and the Appendix 2 to Scottish Government as the council's response to the consultation.
