### 1. MINUTE

### 2. PRIVATE

## 3. <u>CIVIC GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 1982 - TAXI DRIVER'S</u> LICENCE - ITEM 6

The license holder was in attendance and represented by his solicitor Mr Dick Sandeman.

Police Scotland was represented by Inspector Alan Struthers.

Introductions were made by all parties and the procedures explained.

The committee considered a report (copies of which had been circulated) by the Chief Solicitor with regard to the taxi driver's licence.

It was recommended that the committee consider a further suspension or revocation of the license holders licence under Paragraph 11 of Schedule 1 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982.

#### Decision

To suspend with immediate effect for the unexpired portion of the duration of the licence in terms of Paragraph 11(2)(c) of Schedule 1 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982.

## 6. <u>CIVIC GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 1982 - PRIVATE HIRE CAR</u> DRIVER'S LICENCE - ITEM 9

The committee considered a report (copies of which had been circulated) by the Chief Solicitor with regard to the private hire car driver's licence.

It was recommended that an immediate suspension be considered on the grounds of public safety in view of the fact that the license holder had disclosed a medical condition which may affect their fitness to drive a licensed hire car vehicle.

### Decision

- 1. To suspend the private hire car driver's licence with immediate effect for the unexpired portion of the duration of the licence.
- To delegate authority to the Chief Solicitor to recall the suspension when the licence holder is certified as fit to drive by the council's medical advisors.
