6. <u>CIVIC GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 1982 - STREET TRADER'S</u> <u>LICENCE</u>

The applicant was in attendance.

Police Scotland was represented by Inspector Brendan McMahon.

Introductions were made and the procedures explained.

The committee considered a report (copies of which had been circulated) by the Chief Solicitor with regard to a Street Traders Licence application.

It was recommended that the committee consider and determine the application.

Decision

To grant a Street Trader's Licence with a warning regarding future conduct.

7. <u>CIVIC GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 1982 - PRIVATE HIRE CAR</u> <u>DRIVER'S LICENCE</u>

The licence holder was in attendance with a supporter.

Introductions were made by all parties and the procedures explained.

The committee considered a report (copies of which had been circulated) by the Chief Solicitor with regard to the Private Hire Car Driver's Licence.

It was recommended that the committee consider an immediate suspension on the grounds of public safety in view of the fact that the licence holder had disclosed a medical condition which may affect their fitness to drive a licensed hire car vehicle.

Decision

1. To suspend the Private Hire Car Driver's Licence with immediate

effect for the unexpired portion of the duration of the licence; and

2. To delegate authority to the Chief Solicitor to recall the suspension when the licence holder is certified as fit to drive by the council's medical advisors.

8. <u>CIVIC GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 1982 - TAXI DRIVER'S</u> <u>LICENCE</u>

The committee noted that the licence holder was not in attendance.

The committee considered a report (copies of which had been circulated) by the Chief Solicitor with regard to the Taxi Driver's Licence.

It was recommended that the committee consider an immediate suspension on the grounds of public safety in view of the fact that the licence holder had disclosed a medical condition which may affect their fitness to drive a licensed hire car vehicle.

Decision

- 1. To suspend the Taxi Driver's Licence with immediate effect for the unexpired portion of the duration of the licence; and
- 2. To delegate authority to the Chief Solicitor to recall the suspension when the licence holder is certified as fit to drive by the council's medical advisors.
