Attached to the report were the Notice of Review and other relevant documents. The documents identified the policies in the development plan and relevant guidance that had been referred to in the review documents.

The committee decided that the review documents in conjunction with the site visit conducted prior to the meeting provided sufficient information to enable the review to be determined without any further procedure.

The committee then determined the review application in terms of the statutory test and to have regards to the development plan unless material consideration indicated otherwise.

The Local Review Body also took account of the views expressed in the Notice of Review documents.

## 4. NOTICE OF REVIEW APPLICATION NO.1163/FUL/22

by the Chief Solicitor to the Local Review Body regarding an application to review only Condition 3 attached to the grant of planning permission by the Appointed Person for a change of use from hairdresser (Class 1) to café (Class 3 (sui generis) (in retrospect) at 29 Uphall Station Road, Pumpherston

Attached to the report were the Notice of Review and other relevant documents including letters of representation. The documents identified the policies in the development plan and relevant guidance that had been referred to in the review documents.

The committee decided that the review documents in conjunction with the site visit conducted prior to the meeting provided sufficient information to enable the review to be determined without any further procedure.

The committee then determined the review application in terms of the statutory test and to have regards to the development plan unless material consideration indicated otherwise.

The Local Review Body also took account of the views expressed in the Notice of Review documents.

## Decision

To uphold the decision of the Appointed Person and refuse the review application as to amend Planning Condition 3 to allow the hours of operation to be extended to 11pm on a Friday and a Saturday was not acceptable.
